
# YEAR 6 - AUTUMN 2

### English

This term, Year 6 will be using two books as our inspiration for our writing. First, Beowulf by Anthony  $\overline{
m VIKING}$ Horowitz and second, Viking Boy. Beowulf is a Norse BOY



legend based on a Viking Warrior and his adventures. These books both link with our history topic this half term: the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. With both books, we will produce recounts and write from an alternative perspective, learning how to create suspense.



#### <u>Maths</u>

This half term, we will continue to secure our understanding of the four key operations, focusing specifically on

long division. In addition, we will begin our unit on fractions, revising what we have learned in Year 5 and ensuring that we are able to add, subtract, multiply and divide using fractions also.

#### Science

This term, Year 6 will be learning about living things and their habitats. They will classify microorganisms, plants and animals



based on specific characteristics. We will also be comparing the similarities and differences between species and their habitats.

#### Other Curriculum Subjects

History- Our focus for this half term is on Anglo Saxons and Viking Invasions. We will be researching the areas of the globe that the Vikings came from to invade Britain and the reasons why. We will then explore the battles of the British kings, from Ethelred the Unready to the Battle of Hastings in 1066.

PSHE - Becoming more independent. This term, we are going to be exploring what enterprise means, developing ways to manage stress and the democratic voting system.

Computing - the year 6 children will be continuing to learn how to use App Inventor to design and create an app of their own.
