



YEAR 3 - AUTUMN 1

English

This term, Year 3 will be reading *The BFG* by Roald Dahl and basing our unit of writing on this charming story. The plot centres around Sophie and her adventures with a gentle giant. Also this term, we will be looking at Aesop's



fables, delightful short stories that incorporate a moral. Year 3 will use these texts to write a range of different outcomes, including character descriptions, a wanted poster, a short fable and an oral retelling of a Roman legend.

The children are expected to **read every day** and note this in their reading records.





Maths

Our focus this term will be on place value; the children will understand the value of each digit within a two and three-digit number, order and compare numbers up to 1000 and recognise number bonds to 20. Additionally, we will learn how to add and subtract two and three-digit numbers using various representations such as bar model, part, part whole and mental methods.
