

# Boxgrove – Covid-19 Safety Measures

## Hand Sanitising and Designated Entrances



To limit contact with other children, each year group will have their own entrance to the school and start time. When the children arrive and leave the school, they will need to use anti-bacterial hand sanitiser. (In addition, they will wash their hands at regular points throughout the day.)



## One-way System



Across the whole school, there is a one-way system in place for staff and pupils. This will mean that classes will not come in to contact with each other while travelling around the school premises (both inside and outside).



## Classroom



In the classrooms, the children will be sat in rows with only two children at a desk. Children will be sat side-by-side. Each child will have their own stationary so that they are not sharing regularly used items with other children. Any items that do need to be shared (such as iPads and Chrome Books) will be cleaned between uses.



## Break Times



At break times, each class will have their own section of the playground to ensure that they do not come in to contact with children from another bubble (a bubble may be a class or year group). These sections of the playground are marked and the children will be guided through where these areas are on their return to school.



## Lunch Time



At lunch time, each class will have a designated time in the lunch hall and will have an area of the lunch hall where only they will sit and eat their lunch. The tables will be spaced far apart and each class will have their own area for tidying away their dirty dishes and left over food.



## Reading and Homework Books



Children will be able to take books home from the book corner in their classroom but these will be left aside for 48 hours once they are returned to ensure that they are then safe to be taken home by another child. After 48 hours, they will then be placed back in the book corner. Homework will still be set and the children will still have homework books to do their homework in. These will be brought back in to school and the teachers will have access to gloves when marking these.

## P.E. Lessons

P.E. lessons will take place in the playground as much as possible as research has shown that the possibility of virus transmission is further reduced outside. The children will also only take part in activities that promote social distancing and do not involve sharing of equipment. Each class will have their own sections of the playground for these lessons. Children will have both of their P.E. lessons on one day of the week. For that day, we will ask children to wear their P.E. kit to school to reduce the risk of spreading the virus when changing clothes.



## Visitors



We will be limiting the number of people that come on to the school premises. When it is necessary for someone to come on to the school premises they will sanitise their hands on arrival and will also be asked to complete a Track and Trace record before entering the school to allow the school to fully comply with the governments test and trace programme. We will also be asking for parents to complete any forms online. Where this is not possible, there will be a post box outside the main entrance to leave any forms for the school office. Parents and carers will be asked to telephone or e-mail the office as much as possible if they have questions, queries or concerns. Parents, carers and other visitors will only be allowed into the school building with the prior permission of the Head of School. The office staff have the right to turn people away where this is not the case.
