A MIX-UP AT THE ZOO

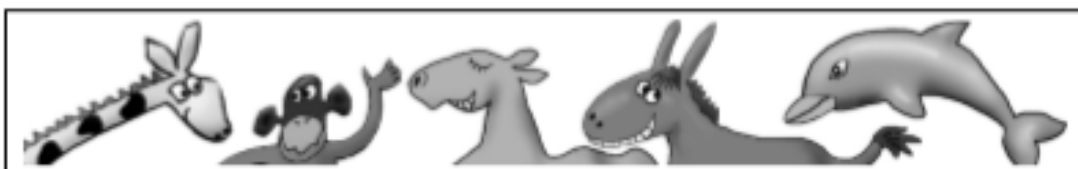
Daisy has just had her first day working at the zoo. This is her letter to her grandmother, but she's put the names of the animals in the wrong places.

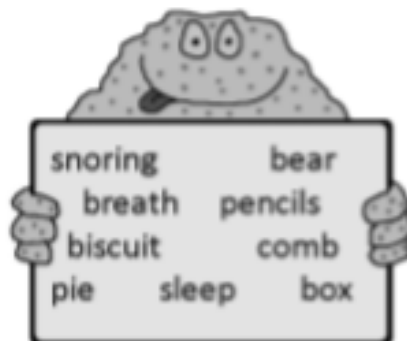
