We looked at the book 'Stickman' and all the children did amazingly well when we went to the theatre to see the stage show. We were very proud of them all!

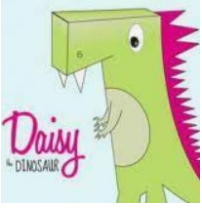


The children also made their own 'Stickmen' using natural objects as part of their learning to follow, read and write instructions.



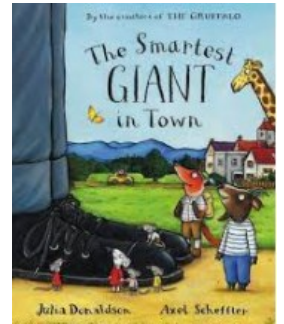
This term

Just as last term we will be planning lots of exciting activities. All children will work on an IT topic focusing on coding and will use these different Apps to develop their skills.



The children in KSI will be looking at familiar texts including 'The Smartest Giant in Town' by Julia Donaldson. We will be learning about nouns and adjectives and using this new knowledge to write correctly structured sentences. As well as matching pictures of characters in the story and sequencing events.

Children in KS2 will be looking at different types of sentences, text types and different punctuation then using these features to write short paragraphs of their own.



In maths all children will be following the White Rose Scheme which begins with a focus of multiplication and division. We will be using lots of different materials to help embed the learning with the children.
