We also made some Valentines themed biscuits in the last week of term.



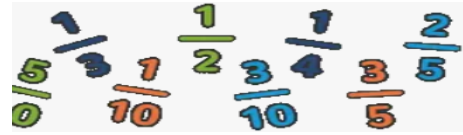
## Maths

We will be learning about patterns and number sequences with the younger children.

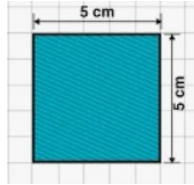
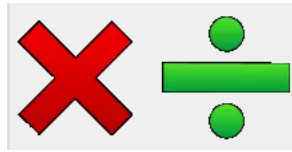
