



#### I TASTE REALLY BAD!

Ladybirds are very common. Here is some information about them.

Ladybirds eat lots of aphids. Aphids are tiny green insects that eat roses and other plants. This is why gardeners and farmers like ladybirds so much.



Ladybirds lay hundreds of eggs among masses of aphids and similar pests. Within a few weeks of hatching, the grub could easily have eaten up to 5000 aphids.

The bright red colour and black spots of ladybirds not only make them easy to see, but also help to protect them.
