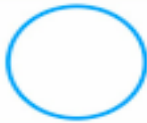
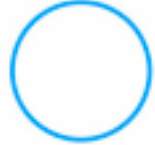


Message in a bottle

Seaside

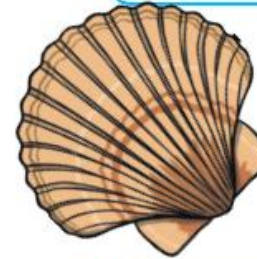
Home Learning Challenges

Here are just a few ideas for you.



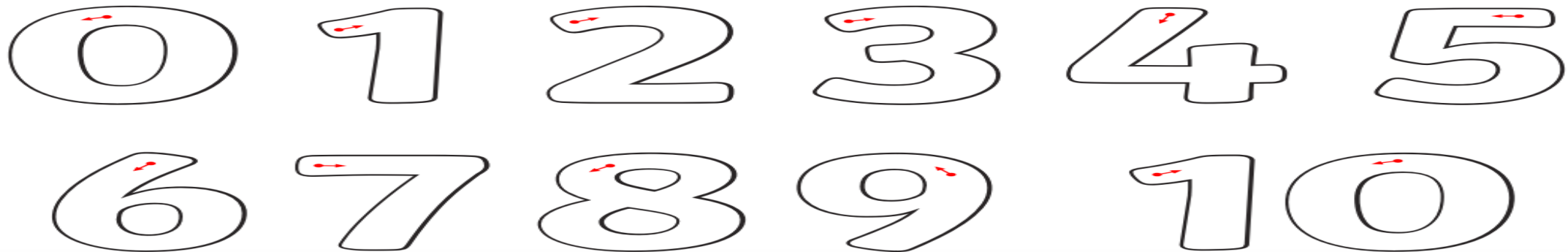
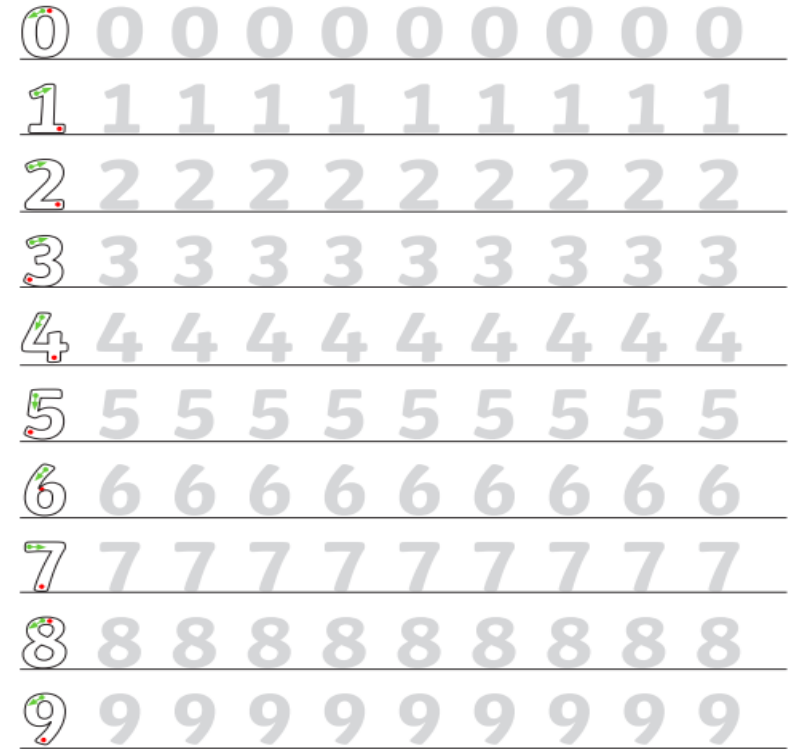
