

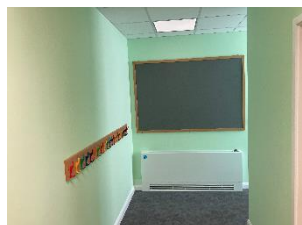


# Boxgrove Primary School

### DSP Update

At Boxgrove, we are near the end of the process of converting part of the school to create a Designated



Special Provision (DSP) for children with a diagnosis of Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Primary ASD DSP provisions are based in mainstream schools and cater for children who have a diagnosis of ASD. The units are designed to meet the needs of children in a mainstream



setting, but that will benefit from the support of a small unit with specialist input during part of the school day. Some photos of how the rooms look at the moment can be seen here. The provision is due to open in January 2021.

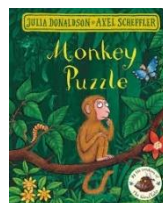
### Presentation Captains

### Monkey Reading Jungle

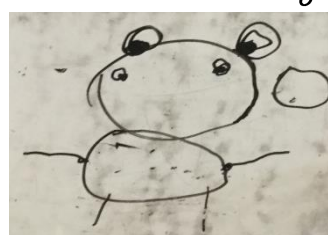
As a part of their topic about Julia Donaldson, the children in Nursery have been reading her book. Recently, they have been reading Monkey
