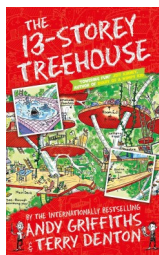


YEAR 3 - SUMMER 1

Maths

This term, Year 3 will be completing our unit on mass, comparing litres and millilitres, and measuring capacity and volume. We will then begin our next fractions unit, adding and subtracting fractions and comparing them. Finally, we will begin our unit of measuring time, telling and writing the time on an analogue clock and exploring Roman numerals. We will also be estimating and reading time, with increasing accuracy.



Science:

In Summer 1, we will be looking at animals including humans and investigating the importance of nutrition. We will be introduced to the main body parts associated with the skeleton and muscles, and we will explore how different parts of the body have special functions.

Geography:

In Summer 1, we will be looking at city settlements and why places are where they are. We will be using geographical skills of using maps and atlases to locate countries and describe features in them. We will also be using a compass to navigate the outdoors.
