Uniform

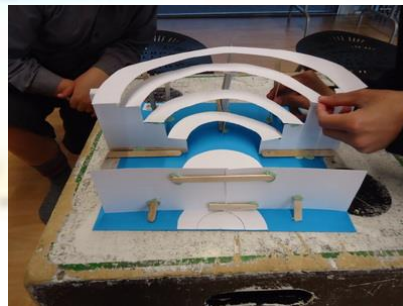
