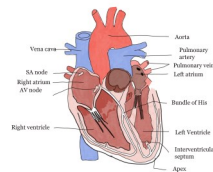

Maths

In maths lessons, Year 6 will be consolidating arithmetic skills with specific focus on fractions. In addition, lessons will be focused on developing reasoning and problem solving skills throughout the curriculum. Key content will focus on algebra, geometry, conversions between fractions, decimals and percentages as well as revising previously taught content.

Science

The topic for this half term is 'animals including humans'. The children will be learning about the human circulatory system and describing the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. Comparisons will be made between humans and other animals.



R.E.

In R.E. this term, Year 6 are looking at how different faiths worship. Children will be encouraged to think about what worship means to them and they will have the opportunity to explore how worship can be expressed through music and art,



PHSE.

In this term, children will be exploring how to 'listen to their bodies' when they react to stress and stressful situations. With specific focus on SATS tests, children will be encouraged to use relaxation techniques to help them through the rest of the year.
